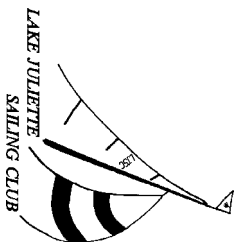

First person to grab the jar with number gets the treasure, swimming walking, running and diving are allowed. No fighting please!!!

White Flag (10 min horn), Blue Flag (5 min horn) and Red Flag (starting horn)
